Background and description of need or problem: Coos Health & Wellness is requesting Board approval for the revised job description for the Electronic Health Records Supervisor position. This modified job description more closely reflects the duties being performed by the Electronic Health Records Supervisor, which include providing 24/7 EHR support for staff and the community, performing back up responsibilities for the IT Department Manager, and overseeing the State's Measures and Outcomes Tracking System (MOTS). Arnold has worked hard to streamline the MOTS network, and has been able to find low cost alternatives to our claims processing procedures, including implementing EDI for Medicaid. Also request Board approval to reclassify the position from paygrade 818 to paygrade 784, and move Arnold to step 2 of the revised payscale, which would result in a monthly increase of \$ 346 per month.

This reclassification would be effective 12/1/2019 and has been budgeted for in the 2019/2020 Coos Health & Wellness budget.



**SIDE AGREEMENT
MENTAL HEALTH PEER SUPPORT SPECIALIST WAGES AND JOB DESCRIPTION**

This Side Agreement is entered into by and between Coos County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon and hereinafter called "COUNTY", and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees Local 2936, hereinafter called "UNION".

WHEREAS, COUNTY and UNION are party to a Collective Bargaining Agreement effective from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020 (hereinafter "CBA"); and



WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the CBA, employees working within the classification of Mental Health Peer Support Specialist are represented by UNION under paygrade 414; and

WHEREAS, Mental Health Peer Support Specialist positions now require certification by the Oregon Health Authority's Traditional Healthcare Worker Program; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and UNION desire to adjust the wage scale for the Mental Health Peer Support Specialist classification for Peer Support Specialists who meet the requirements to become a Qualified Mental Health Associate as determined by the Local Mental Health Authority and the Mental Health & Addictions Certification Board of Oregon (MHACBO);

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Effective December 1, 2019, Mental Health Peer Support Specialists that are also MHACBO certified as a Qualified Mental Health Associate will receive a base salary equivalent to that of the Mental Health Associate II positions at Pay Grade 450, as set forth in Appendix A to this Agreement, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and
2. Eligible individuals will begin receiving Pay Grade 450 in the month following submission of proof of their certification to Human Resources when submitted prior to the 15th of the month. Employees retain sole responsibility for the submission of necessary proof to County.
3. Eligible individuals will be placed on the lowest step within Pay Grade 450 that results in a positive increase in their monthly wage. Additionally, the employee's anniversary date as used for the purposes of future merit step increases will be reset to the date of the initial increase to Pay Grade 450.
4. Qualified Employees, in accepting the higher Pay Grade, agree to the assignment of additional job responsibilities and duties as may relate to their certification as a Qualified Mental Health Associate II and as described within that job position description.
5. As currently required, Mental Health Peer Support Specialists must also continue to be certified and registered as a Peer Support Specialist through the Oregon Health Authority.
6. In the event that the funding sources being used by COUNTY to fund said wage increase are reduced in the future, COUNTY and UNION will negotiate with regard to the issues of layoffs, reduction of hours, and/or reclassification of personnel, if applicable.
7. During the next negotiations between the parties for a successor agreement pursuant to Article XXIV of the CBA, the parties shall negotiate the incorporation of the terms of this Agreement into the CBA.
