

DEADLINES FOR TESTIMONY

ORS 197.763(6)(a)(c). If the hearings authority leaves the record open for additional written evidence, arguments or testimony, the record shall be left open for at least seven days. If new written evidence is submitted at the continued hearing, any person may request, prior to the conclusion of the continued hearing, that the record be left open for at least seven days to submit additional written evidence, arguments or testimony for the purpose of responding to the new written evidence.

- ❖ **The Hearings Officer has chosen to leave the record open for an additional 21 days from the date of the hearing for written rebuttal evidence, argument or testimony. The written evidence, argument and/or testimony must be received by June 10, 2010 @ 5:00 p.m.**
- ❖ **Written surrebuttal evidence or argument (i.e. responding to evidence or argument received between the dates of May 21, 2010 to June 10, 2010) is due by June 17, 2010 @ 5:00 p.m. The evidentiary portion of the record will close at that time.**
- ❖ **Pursuant to ORS 197.763(6)(a)(e), and unless waived by the applicant, the local government shall allow the *applicant* at least seven days after the record is closed to all other parties to submit final written arguments in support of the application. The applicant's final submittal shall be considered part of the record, but shall not include any new evidence. This seven-day period shall not be subject to the limitations of ORS 215.427 and ORS 215.429. This final argument is due by June 24, 2010, @ 5:00 p.m.**

Please note: pursuant to LDO Section 5.7.300(5), written testimony, argument and/or evidence should be submitted as follows:

Required Number of Copies: Submission of written materials for consideration shall be provided as follows for hearings before the:

Board of Commissioners – 7 copies

The County may, at its sole discretion, reject any materials that do not contain the requisite number of copies. It may be requested that the County make the requisite number of copies subject to the submitter paying the applicable copy charges.

E-mail testimony may be submitted; however, it is the responsibility of the person submitting the testimony to verify it has been received by planning staff by the applicable deadline.

All written testimony must contain the name of the person(s) submitting it and current mailing address for mailing of notice.
