**Background and description of need or problem:** There have been complaints about people smoking on County property, including by the front door of the Courthouse. There is also a problem with cigarette butts being disposed on the sidewalk and in the grass. Upon the suggestion of Commissioner Sweet, I have priced receptacles to help alleviate this issue.

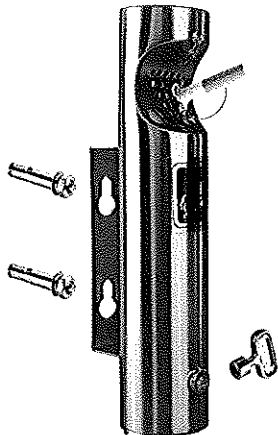

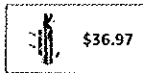

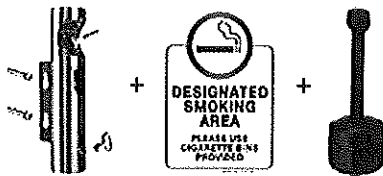
