COMMUNITY DISPUTE RESOLUTION SERVICES**

Notice is hereby given that Coos County and the University of Oregon on behalf of the University of Oregon School of Law (Grantor) are initiating the application and selection process for grant funds available to eligible community dispute resolution programs in Coos County under ORS 36.155. The grant period is July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021, subject to funding authorization by the 2019 Legislature. Assuming funding for 2019-2021 is reauthorized by the 2019 Legislature, grant funds for Coos County will be approximately \$21,320 for this period.
