Shall the District be authorized to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not exceeding \$1,500,000? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words

If approved, this measure would finance capital assets such as:
 replace heating system at Ocean Crest;
 upgrade bathrooms; make ADA compliant;
 provide security glass/shading to improve safety for students/staff;
 replace bell/intercom systems to improve safety and communication;
 replace middle school bleachers;
 replace middle school gym roof;
 resurface District track;
 upgrade playground equipment and structures;
 construct storage building at track to replace old storage trailers;
 improve ventilation and heat systems at middle and high school;
 renovate Quonset Hut adding dry, secure storage areas, redo batting cage area, add bathrooms;
 replace lights with energy-efficient lighting;
 install secure lock system at elementary school;
 pay bond issuance, related construction costs and other capital improvements to district facilities if funds are available.
 It is projected that there would be little or no increase in the levy rate paid by taxpayers over the existing levy. This estimate is based on receiving an allocation of Qualified School Construction Bonds and other market conditions. Bonds would mature in ten years or less from issuance.
