Shall it be unlawful for any entity to transport fossil fuels into Coos County except fuels for onsite use?

**Summary** 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect

A yes vote will:

Establish a bill of rights for a sustainable energy future. Declares current municipal system of governance in Coos County illegitimate and calls for the creation of a new system of municipal governance which recognizes self-governing authority and which ensures and protects rights to a sustainable energy future. Bans the transportation of fossil fuels through and into Coos County except fuels intended for residential, commercial or industrial onsite use for power, heat and vehicle refueling. Bans any land acquisition for construction of a non-sustainable energy system. Declares all laws adopted by the Oregon Legislature or the United States Congress and rules adopted by state, federal or international agencies to be the law of Coos County to the extent they do not violate the rights and prohibitions of this ordinance. Calls for the amendment of the Oregon and Federal Constitutions to confirm the right to local self-government free from governmental preemption and/or nullification by corporate rights.

A no vote leaves in place current law regarding energy transportation and development.
