Bonds to Improve Schools and Classrooms, Address Safety, Repairs, Security

Shall Coos Bay School District issue \$59,995,000 in bonds to construct new schools and update others for safety and security? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.			
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.			
If approved, the bond proceeds are expected to fund:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Construction of a new 7th - 8th Grade School and additional Gym in place of Harding Building; * Construction of a new Elementary School in place of Eastside Elementary to serve as a replacement for Blossom Gulch Elementary; * Additions to Madison Elementary to replace temporary classrooms and restrooms and increase teaching space; * Renovations to Madison, Sunset and Millicoma Schools to improve safety, security, accessibility, efficiency and building systems; * Related capital costs including Building Needs Assessments; * Site Improvements, demolition, furnishings and equipping of projects and bond issuance costs. 			
The district has been awarded a \$4 million grant from the State for these projects. The grant is contingent on passing this bond. Failure to pass the bond will cause these funds to be given to a different district.			
Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 25.25 years from issuance. The estimated tax rate is approximately \$1.60 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Actual rates may differ based upon interest rates and growth in assessed value.
