

2016 Coos County Fair Parade
Saturday, July 30th, at 10 a.m.
"A Barn Full Of Fun For Everyone"

REGISTRATION IS DUE BY 5 P.M. ON FRIDAY, JULY 22nd, TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR RIBBONS.

The parade begins at 10 a.m. with judging taking place between 9 and 9:30 a.m. at the assembly points listed below. Entries will be judged for theme, originality, and neatness.

The parade will be led by the Myrtle Point Police and Fire Departments followed by the Grand Marshal, Junior Division Color Guard, Adult Division Color Guard, Fair Queen, Horse Division (All horse groups are required to provide poop scoopers), and the Tractor Division. Following the tractors, the other divisions will be alternated in line based on compatibility. Participants are encouraged to follow 20 to 25 feet behind the entry in front of them. **NO CANDY TOSSING** from the street; to give candy have people walk and hand it out at the curb. FLOATS DIVISION: Anything on wheels, trailers, or decorated vehicles. Line up starts at the corner of First and Spruce streets by 9 a.m. Judged in line. (See map)

JUNIORS DIVISION: 17 and under clubs, groups, or individuals that are non-floats. Line up and judging takes place on Second Street between Spruce and Ash streets. (See map)

ADULTS DIVISION: 18 and over clubs, groups, or individuals that are non-floats. Line up and judging takes place on Third Street between Spruce and Ash streets. (See map)

MARCHING BANDS DIVISION: Musicians on foot. Line up and judging takes place on Third Street between Spruce and Ash streets. (See map)

HORSE DIVISION: EACH GROUP MUST HAVE POOP SCOOPERS!!!

CLASS A — 4-H. Judging at the Fair Grounds Main Arena beginning at 9 a.m.

CLASS B — Open. Line up starts at the corner of Reedsford Road and Maple Street at 9 a.m.
Judged in line. (See map)

CARS DIVISION: Line up on Spruce Street Bridge at 9 a.m. Judged in line.

TRUCKS DIVISION: 18-wheelers, 4x4s, and non-Myrtle Point Fire Trucks. Line up on the corner of Old Dike Road and Spruce Street at 9 a.m. Judged in line. (See map)

TRACTORS DIVISION: Line up and judging on Fourth Street between Spruce and Ash streets at 9 a.m. (See map)

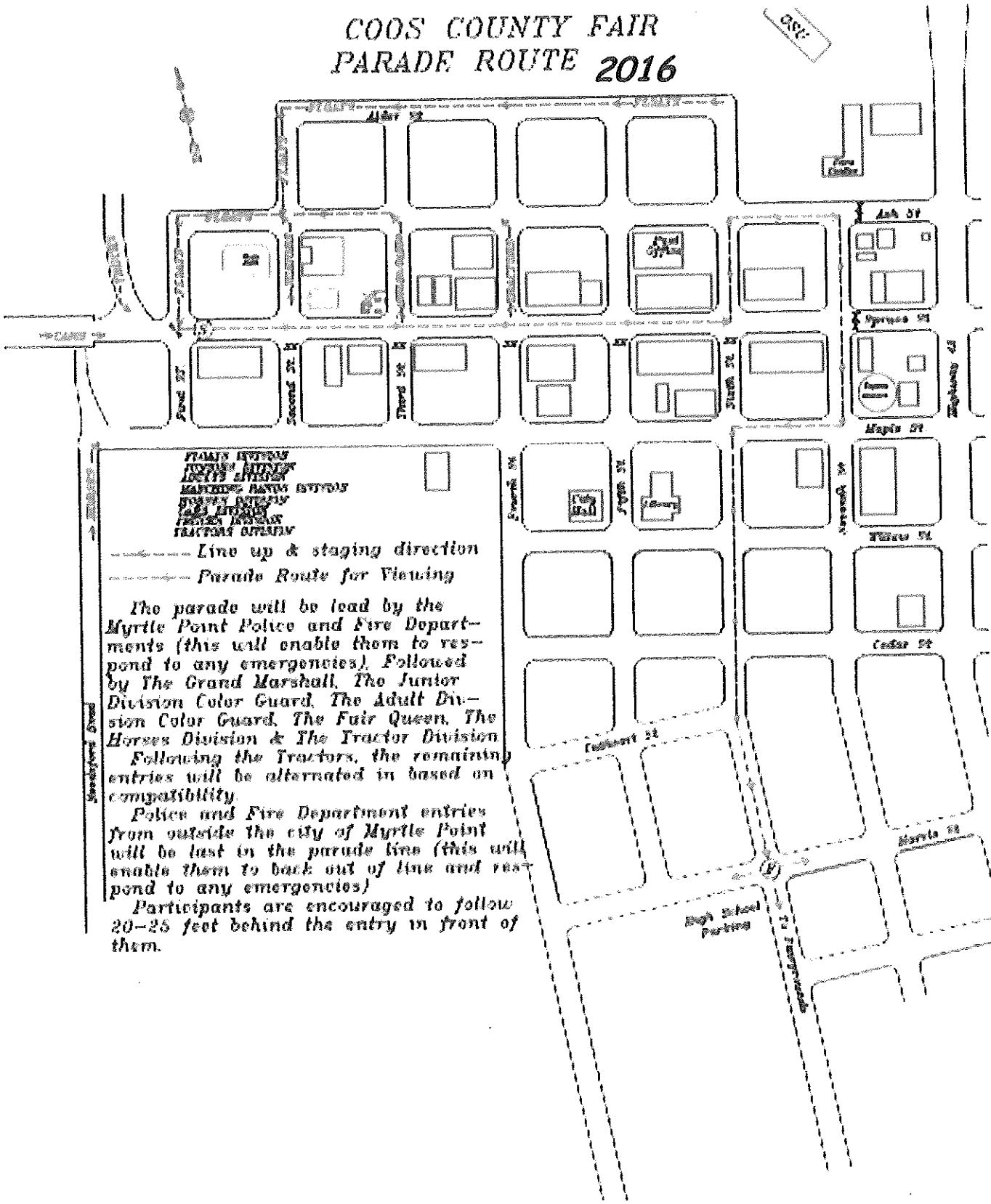

The parade will be lead by the Myrtle Point Police and Fire Departments (this will enable them to respond to any emergencies). Followed by The Grand Marshall, The Junior Division Color Guard, The Adult Division Color Guard, The Fair Queen, The Horses Division & The Tractor Division.

Following the Tractors, the remaining entries will be alternated in based on compatibility.

Police and Fire Department entries from outside the city of Myrtle Point will be last in the parade line (this will enable them to back out of line and respond to any emergencies)

Participants are encouraged to follow 20-25 feet behind the entry in front of them.
