

COOS COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT
PERMIT ADDENDUM FOR PROVIDING ALCOHOL

Alcohol is allowed at the _____ Shelter at _____
County Park subject to the following conditions:

1. A group, business or other organization (Group) that is having a scheduled event at the Park and desires to provide alcohol shall obtain any required OLCC Permit(s). The Group shall comply with all requirements of such permit(s). The Group shall provide the Coos County Parks Department a copy of all such permits.
2. The Group or the alcohol server shall purchase and maintain at its own expense liability insurance covering the Group, the alcohol server, their employees, agents and members and shall also require all subcontractors to obtain such insurance. All such insurance shall be no less than the minimum limits of ORS 30.270 (currently \$500,000 per occurrence). The Group or alcohol server shall file a Certificate of Insurance with the Coos County Parks Department at least one week before the event. The Certificate shall provide for thirty- (30) days written notice of cancellation or material change. All insurance is subject to the approval of the County. A Certificate of Insurance is required for the following policy:

Commercial General Liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage. Coos County shall be listed as an **ADDITIONAL INSURED** using ISO Form #CG 20 10 1/85 or an equivalent. This insurance shall include but is not limited to:

- Broad Form Contractual Liability
 - Liquor Liability
3. The Parks Department shall designate the area in which alcohol may be provided and consumed. The Group shall not allow consumption of alcohol outside of the _____ Shelter area. No minors shall be permitted within the designated area.
 4. The Group shall provide security as required by the Parks Department.
