

COOS COUNTY PARKS RULES & REGULATIONS  
(BRIEF FORM)

1. No person shall enter or use camping facilities without paying the prescribed fee.
2. Users of County Parks must comply with all posted signs.
3. Pets shall be secured by a leash not over 10 ft. long and shall not be left unattended in a County Park. No dogs are allowed in the day use areas.
4. No person shall bring any animal, other than a seeing-eye dog, into any County Park building.
5. No person shall discharge any firearm in a County Park.
6. No person shall operate or use any noise producing machine, vehicle, or instrument in such a manner that is disturbing to other Park users.
7. Day use areas close at dusk. Quiet time in the Parks Campgrounds is from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
8. The abuse of alcoholic liquors is prohibited in a County Park.
10. No bottled beverages are permitted within a swimming or playground area.
11. No person shall bring into a Park any garbage for the purpose of leaving it therein.
12. No person shall clean any seafood, except at places designated by the Parks Department.
13. No person shall set up or use a public address system in a County Park.
14. No person shall pick or mutilate any foliage or any park structures.
15. No fire shall be built, lit or maintained within a County Park, except in a camp stove or a fireplace designated for such purposes. The user shall extinguish all fires before leaving the Park.
16. FOURTEEN DAYS is the maximum length of stay in a Coos County campground.
17. No Person shall use abusive, threatening, boisterous, vile, obscene or indecent language or gestures within a County Park.

18. In order to enforce all rules and regulations, and to maintain a sanitary and orderly appearance in the County parks, the County Park Employee in charge of each Park is vested with the authority to require all persons using said Park to abide by the rules and regulations, as well as the authority to determine the size, type and arrangement of individual camping facilities in the Park. HE/SHE MAY EJECT ANYONE FROM THE PARK WHO WILL NOT CONFORM TO PARK REGULATIONS.
19. A park employee may revoke any permit when there is reasonable cause to believe the permit holder has violated any provisions of the permit, Coos County Park regulations or state law.
20. Obey posted speed rules.
21. VANDALISM- violators will be prosecuted.
22. Check out time for campers is 2:00 p.m.
