APPEALS

All appeals must include information indicating that the elevations and/or delineations are scientifically and/or technically incorrect. Appeals must be supported with scientific and technical data and mapping demonstrating that alternative methods or applications result in more correct estimates of base flood elevations. To file an appeal, submit a signed letter with the corresponding technical information to your respective jurisdiction and FEMA, if desired, as follows. Your local government, contacts above, will review and submit formally to FEMA.

Comments and appeals are due by the end of the 90-day appeal period, currently projected to start in April 2017. Updated information on the actual appeal start date and end date will be provided to your community contact prior to the start.
