## **PRESS RELEASE**

**Crime(s): Delivery and Possession of Methamphetamine, Theft, Felon in Possession of a Firearm, Frequenting.**

**Narrative: In March of 2015 SCINT Detectives obtained information and conducted an investigation into the Delivery of Methamphetamine by Bruce Everett Taylor, Kevin Lee Marshall and others in the Barview Area of Coos County.**

**As a result of the investigation search warrants were obtained for Taylor's and Marshall's respective residences.**

**On March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015, SCINT Detectives assisted by the Oregon State Police, the Coos County Sheriff's Office, the Coos Bay Police Department, the North Bend Police Department, the Douglas County Interagency Narcotics Team (DINT), the Coquille Tribal Police, Coquille Tribal Drug Detection Canine Stormy and the Brookings Police Department executed warrants nearly simultaneously at the two residences.**

**During the search of Bruce Taylor's Wallace Road residence detectives seized scales, packaging material, drug transactions records, a firearm and more than a half pound of methamphetamine.**

**In April of 2016 Bruce Taylor was found guilty by a jury of his peers of Possession and Delivery of Methamphetamine as well as Frequenting a place where drugs are used or sold. Bruce Taylor was sentenced to forty months prison for his crimes.**

**During the March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015 search of Kevin Marshall's residence on South Spring Road detectives seized scales, packaging material, drug transaction records, firearms, stolen property and a quarter pound of methamphetamine.**

**In April of 2016 Kevin Marshall was found guilty of Assault II and other related crimes in a separate incident. Marshall fled the court prior to the conclusion of his trial and being placed into custody.**

*SCINT is partially funded by the US Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services and the US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance. The funding is provided through the COPS Methamphetamine Initiative (60%) and Congressionally Selected Awards Program (40%).*

**As might be expected Marshall did not appear for trial on April 26<sup>th</sup> 2016 to face the charges stemming from the March 2015 search warrant service as his residence and is currently a fugitive from justice.**
