Robber Sentenced to 70 Months



Coquille, Oregon on June 22nd, Jessica Rose Toepfer was sentenced to 70 months in prison after pleading guilty to Robbery in the Second Degree.

On April 16th, 2015 Coos County Deputies were dispatched to Frontage Road in Myrtle Point Oregon for a report of a fight involving a firearm. Close to midnight, Toepfer and two other individuals arrived at the victim's home. The victim was called out of the home and upon exiting the residence an argument ensued. During the melee a co-defendant took a shooting stance, it was believed a gun was drawn, and witnesses reported hearing what sounded like the click of a handgun. Toepfer was observed extracting property from the victim's vehicle through a now broken window. Another resident of the home attempted to render aid, but in the process Toepfer began to strike the victim about the head.

The three defendants fled the scene and were apprehended by Myrtle Point Police. Coos County Deputies arrived at the stop to continue their investigation. No firearm was located in the stopped vehicle, but outside the vehicle a set of digital scales was located. At the original crime scene, deputies located a unspent 40 caliber bullet in the victim's driveway. Additionally, a dagger with a swastika was located and believed to have caused some of the property damage.

Deputy Sanborn continued the investigation assisted by SCINT detectives. A search warrant was obtained and a search of Toepfer's purse and a co-defendant's backpack revealed methamphetamine and methamphetamine paraphernalia. Communications were located in which it was learned the defendant's were attempting to collect a debt.

SCINT is partially funded by the US Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services and the US Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance. The funding is provided through the COPS Methamphetamine Initiative (40%) and Congressionally Selected Awards Program (60%).

A Coos County Grand Jury charged Toepfer with three counts of Robbery in the First Degree, three counts of Robbery in the Second Degree, Theft in the Second Degree, Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree, two Counts of Robbery in the Third Degree, and Criminal Forfeiture. Toepfer pleaded guilty to the Measure 11 crime of Robbery in the Second Degree. Pursuant to the Measure 11 Oregon Sentencing Guidelines, Toepfer was sentenced to a total of seventy months in prison followed by thirty-six months post-prison supervision.
