**Crime(s):** PCS Methamphetamine, Endangering the Welfare of a Minor

**Narrative:**

On Friday September 21, 2012 the South Coast Interagency Narcotics Team (SCINT) responded to assist the Coquille Police Department, Coos County Community Corrections and Child Protective Services case workers at 382 W. Central Ave, Apt #5 in Coquille.

A subsequent investigation revealed Methamphetamine, suspected heroin, and drug use paraphernalia in the residence. Arrested at the residence were Ronald Chambers-Delzell (36 yoa) and Shaydeen Marie Fields (22 yoa) of Coquille.

Both were transported to the Coos County Jail and lodged on charges of unlawful possession of methamphetamine and endangering the welfare of a minor. Chambers-Delzell is additionally being held on a probation violation. CPS case workers removed a 2 year old child from the residence for placement into protective custody.
