Crime(s): MCS Methamphetamine

Narrative:

On Sunday October 14, 2012 the South Coast Interagency Narcotics Team (SCINT) responded to Bureau of Land Management (BLM) lands in rural North Eastern, Coos County. Geographically this location is best described as near where the Weaver Ridge Road and Camas Creek tie road intersect.

The purpose of the response was to investigate suspicious items located by hunters. A subsequent investigation revealed numerous chemicals and items including a breathing apparatus used in the illicit manufacture of crystal methamphetamine. No environmental damages had been inflicted; it is suspected that the items had been at the location less than 48 hours.

SCINT is requesting any information or tips from the public regarding any suspicious activities or out of the ordinary vehicles that were observed in this general vicinity between October 12th and 14th.

SCINT was assisted by the Douglas County and Coos County Sheriff's Offices.
