



## Coos County Noxious Weed Control District Advisory Board



### 2019 Coos County Herbicide Cost-Share Program

The Coos County Noxious Weed Control District Advisory Board (Advisory Board) provides assistance to control noxious weeds in Coos County. One of the programs initiatives is to assist landowners through the Cost-Share Program. The County through the Weed Control District will provide up to 40% of the cost of the negotiated price of herbicide and surfactant for 2019. Each landowner is responsible for the cost of the application. The applicants cost is shown on page two. Final prices will be calculated with authorized amounts prior to the training.

This year the cost-share program will assist landowners desiring to control Coos County “T” list noxious weeds. “T” list weeds are "targeted for control” throughout the County. Landowners with “T” list weeds are encouraged to control these priority weeds and apply for this Cost-Share program.

All Coos County “T” list weeds are shown in the table below along with the recommended herbicide active ingredient. More detailed information on management of noxious weeds is available in the Pacific Northwest Weed Management Handbook <https://pnwhandbooks.org/weed>.

The herbicide products listed in this announcement are not an endorsement of particular brands or manufacturers. Instead, these are products that are available from the contract selected, and products with the same concentration of active ingredient and site registration, may be substituted. The Advisory Board has included the herbicides and surfactants based on the guidance from the Pacific Northwest Weed Management Handbook to treat “T” list weeds.

It is the landowner’s (or their applicator’s) responsibility to ensure compliance with all use and safety instructions on the label. The label is the law showing how the herbicide may be used and following the label will give best results.

#### **Instructions and important dates for Cost-Share Program**

1. **April 15, 2019 – Cost-Share Applications** – Applications are available for participants to fill out. However, there will be a public help session.
2. **May 21, 2019 - Help Session 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.** - A Cost-Share Application Help Session will be held in the conference room at the Owen Building, 201 N. Adams, in Coquille Oregon. The Advisory Board strongly advises applicants to attend this session to ensure applications are accurately completed and any questions answered. Applications may be turned in at this session.
3. **May 31, 2019 - Applications Deadline 5:00 p.m.** - All applications must be completed by the landowner and returned to the Advisory Board no later than 5:00 p.m. (see next page for address).
4. **June 14, 2019 – Notification** - Applicants will learn the results by mail no later than June 14. Notifications will include the amount of herbicide cost-share granted and the final cost of herbicides and surfactants, as well as payment terms and conditions. 5. **June 26, 2018 – Required Training 6:00 p.m.** – Training is required prior to receiving any cost-share herbicides. Training will be at the Owen Building (201 N. Adams, Coquille OR 97423). If you cannot attend training you may not be eligible for the cost share grant. If you cannot attend the training, be sure to go to the help session May 21, 2019 or contact the Planning Department at 541-396-7770 or by email at [planning@co.coos.or.us](mailto:planning@co.coos.or.us). A current applicator’s license may be substituted for required training (include applicator’s license number on application).
  
6. Funds available for the cost-share program are limited. The application evaluation process will include the size of infestation and/or property size. There may be other programs and training that may benefit you. See the program website for more information
