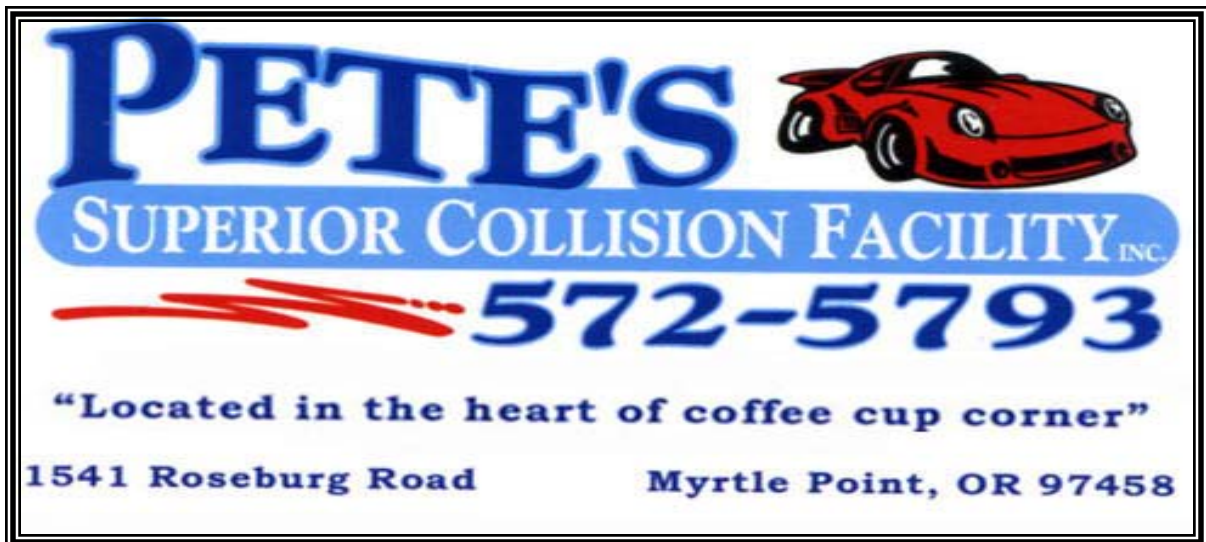
FFA RECORDBOOKS
