Shall Bandon impose \$.8455 per \$1,000 of assessed value for streets and pedestrian capital projects for 10 years beginning 2011-2012? This measure renews current local option taxes.

Summary 175 words

The purpose of this measure is to give Bandon voters the option of continuing an existing local option tax to fund street and pedestrian facility improvements. This tax was originally approved in 2001 for 10 years, and was used to eliminate all gravel streets, pave deteriorated streets, and improve pedestrian facilities throughout Bandon. The local option tax approval also precluded the Urban Renewal Agency from imposing a special levy tax for the last 10 years. A YES vote will renew the local option tax for an additional 10 years, and will continue to prohibit the Urban Renewal Agency from imposing a special levy tax. A NO vote would cause the current local option tax to expire, and would allow the Urban Renewal Agency to impose a special levy tax. The local option tax can be used throughout Bandon, whereas the Urban Renewal special levy tax could only be used within designated Urban Renewal areas. Approximately 90% of Bandon lies outside the Urban Renewal areas, with only about 10% of Bandon within the Urban Renewal areas. The proposed rate will raise the following estimated amounts: \$338,175 in 2011-2012, \$338,175 in 2012-2013, \$338,175 in 2013-2014, \$338,175 in 2014-2015, \$338,175 in 2015-2016, \$338,175 in 2016-2017, \$338,175 in 2017-2018, \$338,175 in 2018-2019, \$338,175 in 2019-2020, and \$338,175 in 2020-2021, for a total of \$3,381,750.
