Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the district's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

General Obligation Bond to construct, renovate and improve district facilities

Shall District issue \$13,210,000 in General Obligation bonds and receive \$4,000,000 state matching grant to construct, renovate and improve facilities? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

Coquille School District No. 8 will receive a \$4,000,000 state grant if these bonds for \$13,210,000 are approved. Bond and grant funds are expected to finance capital costs, including:

- Building security/safety improvements;
- Seismic Upgrades at Coquille High School;
- Update aging schools electrical, roofing, plumbing, heating at Lincoln Elementary, Coquille Valley Elementary, Winter Lakes Elementary, Coquille High;
- Upgrade Vocational opportunities and Career Technical Education spaces;
- Relieve overcrowding by adding additional classrooms at Winter Lakes Elementary and Coquille Jr/Sr High; and
- Construct gym to community shelter standards at Winter Lakes High

General Obligation Bonds would mature in not to exceed 31 years from issuance and may be issued in series. The District would establish a citizen oversight committee to ensure proceeds are used for purposes indicated. The estimated cost in annual tax levy rate is \$0.67 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Actual levy rate may differ due to change in interest and assessed value.


