Bonds for constructing/equipping combined Library and 911 Communication Center		
<b>Question</b> 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.		
Shall City of Coos Bay issue \$20,000,000 general obligation bonds for a new combined Library and 911 Communication Center? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.		
<b>Summary</b> 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.		
This measure authorizes the City to issue general obligations bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$20 million, funding a portion of costs to construct an approximately 32,700 square foot combined Library and 911 Communications Center in John Topits Park. This new library replaces the existing structurally failing library on Anderson Avenue and is expected to include space for library collections, study and computer locations, as well as community meeting and age-specific programming spaces. Additionally, passage will provide necessary expansion of the 911 Communication Center and emergency sheltering capabilities. The City expects to supplement bond proceeds with approximately \$4.5 million in community member donations, grants, and urban renewal funds for the balance of the costs, associated parking and site improvements. If the maximum bond amount is issued, the average property tax rate would be approximately \$0.97 cents per \$1,000 Assessed Value (not Real Market Value); rates may differ due to actual interest rates and changes in assessed value. The bonds may be issued in series and mature in not more than 25 years.
