"County Commissioner" – 4-year terms

Candidate(s) will be printed on the Primary Election Ballot.

- If a candidate receives a majority of votes cast for the office, that candidate is elected at the Primary Election.
- If no candidate receives a majority of votes cast for the office, the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes are nominated and their names will be printed on the General Election ballot.

"County Sheriff" or "County Clerk" Position – 4-year terms

If only 1 or 2 candidate(s) file for the office at the Primary they are both considered nominated and go forward to the General Election and their name(s) will be printed on the <u>General Election ballot only</u>. The candidate(s) name(s) <u>will not</u> appear on the Primary Election ballot. ORS 249.091 (County Clerk, Sheriff, County Treasurer positions only)

If three (3) or more candidates file for the office at the Primary, their names will be printed on the Primary Election Ballot.

- If **one** (1) candidate receives the **majority of votes** that candidate is then "nominated" and his/her name will be printed on the General Election ballot.
- If **no** candidate receives the **majority of votes**, the top two (2) candidates who received the most votes will go forward to the General Election and their names will be printed on the General Election ballot.
