

Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the county's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

A five-year levy to increase jail funding and capacity.		
Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.		
Shall Coos County increase to 150 jail beds by levying \$.45 per \$1,000 assessed valuation for five years commencing 2023/24? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.		
Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.		
<p>Passage of this measure will allow Coos County and the Coos County Sheriff's Office to provide funding for a minimum of 150 local jail beds for the five-year period. Increased jail capacity will improve the Sheriff's ability to hold those accused or convicted of crimes until their cases are resolved or their time has been served.</p> <p>The funds generated from this tax must be placed into a restricted special revenue fund specifically earmarked for jail services. An external auditor will annually present in a public forum an independent audit report to the Sheriff and Coos County Board of Commissioners to ensure accountability.</p> <p>After five years, this tax rate automatically expires unless re-approved by Coos County voters. This measure generates revenue for five years beginning in 2023. For the median home in Coos County, valued at \$231,370, the annual tax payment will increase by no more than \$104.12.</p> <p>The estimated taxes raised by this levy are 2023/24 - \$2,516,476.43; 2024/25 - \$2,591,970.72; 2025/26 - \$2,669,729.84; 2026/27 - \$2,749,821.74; 2027/28 - \$2,832,316.39 for a total of \$13,360,315.12.</p>
