Welcome to the March 12, 2024 Special Election cycle for the City of Lakeside.

Coos County Elections would like to take a moment to share some important dates and information regarding the upcoming Election.

- The last day to register, in order to qualify for this election, is Tuesday, February 20, 2024
- Ballots will be mailed to voters on February 22, 2024. If a voter, residing in the City of Lakeside, does not receive their ballot by Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, they should contact the Coos County Elections Office.
- A public demonstration of ballot programming and tabulation will be held on February 23, 2024 at 9:00am
- The first report of election results will be available on the Coos County website at approximately 8:00pm on Election Day. A full schedule of when results will be released can be found on the Coos County website.
- Everyone interested is welcome to come observe the election process. Additional information as well as the required forms for observation can be found on the Coos County website.

This office would like to stress that ballots are not forwarded by the post office, so if a voter has moved or changed their mailing address, they need to update their registration. This may be done online at <a href="https://www.oregonvotes.gov/myvote">www.oregonvotes.gov/myvote</a> or by completing a physical Voter Registration Card.

If mailing, ballots must be postmarked by the United States Postal Service no later than Election Day and be received in the office of the County Clerk no later than 7 days after Election Day. If utilizing an official drop-site location, ballots must be in the drop-box no later than 8:00pm on Election Day. The list of available drop-site locations is listed on the Coos County website and will also be printed on the ballot.
