Summary:

- The team met with the Housing Action Team regarding the upcoming Housing Summit at the Mill Casino.
 - We assisted with the audio/visual for the event as well as having a table, and being a member of the Housing Panel with a presentation about HB5019 funding opportunities.
 - Our goal with this is to increase partner collaborations and educate those who might be able to take advantage of some of our HB5019 funding.
- Set up presentations with the City Managers for the Cities of Lakeside, Powers, and Bandon regarding Safe Spot Camping Communities.
 - Safe Spot Communities were able to present to our Faith Based Stakeholder group.
 - A presentation was given at Powers City Council meeting last Tuesday to educate the Council and the public on starting a community in that area.
- Continued collaboration with AYA on 5019 funds
 - Working with Scott Cooper on allowable expenses through the grant to create a more accurate budget for program delivery as well as direct client expenses.
 - Attempted to connect with the finance office of North Bend to set up the reimbursement process..

Partner Engagement

- This past month we engaged with all three of our Stakeholder Groups, by having a Special Guest Speaker Judy Hui-Pasquini from OHCS. She wanted to discuss a future EHA program through their agency which would primarily focus on rapid rehousing for children and their families experiencing homelessness.
 - Each Stakeholder group was engaged with a set of questions meant to determine if our region would benefit from receiving this funding. This information was relayed to OHCS and recommendations were made.
