RESIDENT CARETAKER - JOB DESCRIPTION

POWERS PARK LOCATION

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

Maintains and enforces regulations as a caretaker and watchman of a County park; does related work as required. This is an unpaid position. Caretaker is expected to perform duties for approximately 20 hours per week on park duties. Caretaker is provided with a rent-free 3-bedroom, 2 bath home. Utilities, water, and garbage paid for by County. Phone and internet hookup are caretaker's responsibility. NO PETS.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the general supervision of the Parks Director or Park Ranger who outlines operative policies and regulations and reviews activities for adequacy of results obtained.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED:

Supervision is not a responsibility of this position.

EXAMPLES OF PRINCIPAL DUTIES:

- 1. Enforces park rules and regulations, registers vehicles and visitors, directs the general public in their use of park and recreation facilities, and performs related duties as required.
- 2. Cleans restrooms and performs light maintenance tasks.
- 3. Collects fees when required.
- 4. Provides security during weekends and evenings when park ranger is not on duty.
- 5. Landscape and lawn maintenance.

RECRUITING REQUIREMENTS, KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:

Must have ability to interact courteously with the public, to provide information regarding park regulations and facilities, and to ensure the safety and welfare of the public; ability to patrol grounds and to enforce regulations; some mechanical knowledge is helpful. Basic computer skills for online reservation system.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

Completion of high school; or any satisfactory combination of experience and training.
