

## **Buildings off-limits**

No animals other than seeing-eye dogs shall be allowed in any building or structure.

## **Horses**

No person shall ride, drive, lead, or keep a saddle horse or other animal in any park area, except on such roads, trails, or areas designated for that purpose. No horse or other animal shall be hitched or confined in a manner that may cause damage to any tree, shrub, improvement or structure.

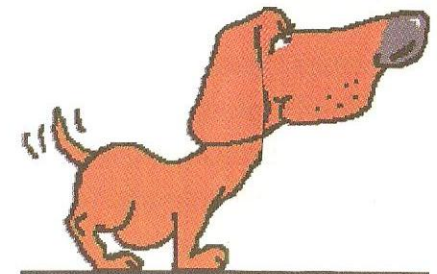

# Your Pet

## **PLEASE REMEMBER:**

Pets are welcome in Coos County parks, but the following rules must be observed.

### **On leash**

Any dog, cat, or other animal brought into or kept in a park area shall be confined in a vehicle, or on a leash not more than ten (10) feet long, and kept under physical control at all times.

### **Clean-up**

The owner is responsible for the animal's behavior and containment and for the removal of the animal's wastes while in the park area.

### **Asked to leave**

The park ranger has the authority to undertake any measures deemed necessary (including the removal of the animal from the park area) to protect park resources and to prevent interference by the animal with the safety, comfort, and well-being of park visitors.



## **COURTESY RULES**

-  Don't leave pets unattended for long periods of time.
-  Don't lock pets in a car, camper, or trailer without food, water, and proper ventilation.
-  Don't tie your pet where a child or an unsuspecting visitor not knowing the animal's disposition may be bitten or injured.
-  Walk your pets in designated areas whenever such areas are provided. Otherwise, use isolated areas away from the campgrounds, picnic, and play areas.
