I believe that the proposed Jordan Cove project will unreasonably interfere with my public trust rights to use Coos Bay for recreational purposes. I am an outdoor enthusiast who enjoys kayaking in this wonderful area. The Jordan Cove project would interfere with the public's usage and enjoyment of the bay by its plan to allow huge ships to access the bay, and to have a security exclusion zone on 500' on all sides during the 240 transits per year at high tide.

This would restrict usage of the bay to only those large ships carrying the LNG product at the most desirable times for fishing and other recreational pursuits.

I also believe that the proposed dredging that is planned in order to widen the shipping channel to accommodate these larger ships, will further erode the public trust rights to those who wish to use Coos Bay for recreational and commercial fishing purposes.
