As a licensed OR fishing guide, I wish to express my objection to planned LNG facility activity, especially around high tide in Coos Bay. A 500 foot exclusion zone around tankers around high tide would effectively eliminate sport fishing in the area, and would violate our existing access rights under the Public Trust Doctrine in favor of private energy corporations. Further, dredging for the terminal would irrevocably harm existing flats that are essential for the local fisheries. □
