Everbridge is the mass notification system used in Coos County and most of Oregon.

You must opt-in to the system to receive alerts. Your information is protected and will not be used for any other purpose. You can subscribe through the Coos County Sheriffs Office Website. You can also download the app to check for alerts as you travel through participating counties.

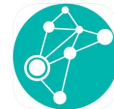
ShakeAlert

This is an Earthquake early warning system for Oregon, Washington, and California.

The system detects an earthquake moments after it begins, so alerts can be sent to people in the affected area. Because information travels faster than the earthquake waves, alerts can reach people quickly—even before they begin to feel shaking. There are currently two ShakeAlert powered apps available to Oregon: QuakeAlertUSA and MyShake.

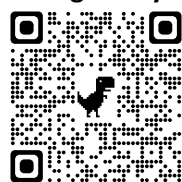

This app is a product of NANOOS and provides tsunami evacuation details for users in the Pacific Northwest.

When using this app, you can explore the local tsunami inundation zone maps and obtain information for specific addresses. You can also sign up to receive alerts, such as notifications stating there is no tsunami threat following an earthquake.

Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA)

Did you know the WEA can be disabled on your device during system updates?

Follow the steps below to ensure your WEA are enabled.

Android Devices:

1. Go to Settings
2. Select Safety and Emergency
3. Select Wireless emergency alerts
4. Enable alerts

Apple Devices:

1. Go to Settings
2. Select Notifications
3. Scroll to the bottom of the screen
4. Under Government Alerts, ensure "On" is enabled

Other Devices:

1. Go to Settings
2. Search for "Emergency Alerts" or "Public Safety messages"
3. Enable the alerts
