ANIMAL REGISTRATION

Pursuant to ORS 609.100 every person residing within the County and owning or keeping any dog which has as set of permanent canine teeth, or is six (6) months old, whichever comes first shall, within thirty (30) days after he or she becomes owner or keeper of the dog, procure from the county in which the person resides, a license for the dog by paying to the county a license fee. The county shall...supply the licensee... with a suitable identification tag, which shall be fastened by the licensee to a collar and kept on the dog at all times when not in the immediate possession of the licensee.

Coos County Code - Section 05.01.070 - Licenses shall be valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance or until the expiration of the rabies immunity, whichever first occurs. A dog owner shall renew the dog license before it becomes delinquent for as long as he or she owns the dog. If the person fails to procure a license within the time provided in this section, there will be an additional charge in the amount of \$4.00.

RABIES VACCINATION:

OAR 333-019-0017 Rabies vaccine shall be administered only by a LICENSED VETERINARIAN. The rabies vaccination certificate shall be completed and signed by the LICENSED VETERINARIAN performing the vaccination. The veterinarian shall give the original and one copy to the dog's owner and retain one copy for the period that the vaccination is in force. 333-019-0019: The owner of a vaccinated dog shall present, in person or by mail, the original copy of the Rabies

Vaccination Certificate to the County Clerk - serving his/her area of residence as a prerequisite to issuance of a license for that dog. No official of any county shall issue a license for a dog until he has been shown a copy of the Rabies Vaccination Certificate for that dog.
