6 THIS MATTER HAVING COME BEFORE the Board of Commissioners at a  
7 worksession held October 25, 2022 and whereas Coos County has elected to advance certain  
8 municipalities taxes, as provided in O.R.S. 311.392, in prior years and that the current Coos  
9 County budget provides for such advancement during this fiscal year; and

10 WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of Commissioners that it is more economical to  
11 advance certain municipalities the total amount of taxes, assessments and other charges  
12 levied for the tax year less the rebate amount from the General Fund of the County; and

13 WHEREAS, a resolution approved by the Board of Commissioners on  
14 October 26, 2021, limited the taxes to be advanced in a fiscal year to districts which have  
15 imposed taxes or assessments on property in the amount of Forty-two Hundred Thirty-three  
16 Dollars (\$4,233) or less; and


17 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of Coos County and the taxing districts to  
18 advance taxes to districts which have imposed taxes and/or assessments on property in the  
19 amount of Forty-three Hundred Nine Dollars (\$4,309) or less;


20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the taxes, assessments and other  
21 charges levied for the 2022-2023 tax year, less the stated rebate, be advanced to the districts  
22 as shown in Exhibit 1, and by this reference made a part hereof by the Coos County Clerk, and  
23 that this advancement be made with a check payable to the Coos County Treasurer and be  
24 charged against General Fund line item number 001-9900-415.95-01, Payment of Advanced  
25 Taxes, and be credited to the districts' trust funds and that the Coos County Treasurer turn, to  
26 the districts, the advanced taxes by December 1, 2022;
